NEW BUSINESS

1. Treasurer's Report - see attached document.

 - a. We have added 4 more members, and more renewing members.
 - b. As of 2010 - funds have declined, however not as much as previous year.
 - c. 24-25 more members would allow us to break even. To work on for upcoming year.
 - d. Miscellaneous items in the budget report are things like constant contact and remember that as of the business meeting, the conference fees have not been paid.
 - e. Jim - we need to think creatively about ways to increase revenue while maintaining ATMI core values/mission.
 - f. James Ackman - students - good idea - students seem to be very interested in this area, should tap into this.
 - g. Jim - clarify, undergrad memberships.
2. Social Media Update
 - a. We need a person to take the lead on the social media part of ATMI. We need a "Facebook/Twitter" person.
 - i. Overall, we have these two accounts, but nothing much is coming from them.
 - b. Someone asked, should we have a closed Facebook page, or a members only page?
 - i. The consensus was that it should remain "open" so if people search for it they will be able to find it.
 - c. One thing we could all do is invite everyone you know to join the ATMI Facebook group. Maybe by doing this, and promoting a little more, the membership will increase (in the long run). Brenden McConvill (*not sure about name spelling*).

3. ATMI Newsletter Update

- a. Members should have received the first newsletter (or link to it) just prior to the 2011 conference.
- b. Thanks to Barbra Murphy.
- c. News letter purpose
 - i. Barbara – If we had enough short articles, we could eventually shift the newsletter into a “juried newsletter.”
 - ii. Jim - Newsletter could be announcements, practical avenue, rather than (social rather than juried)
 - iii. Gena - a good way to spread the word about what we're all doing and provide links to conference materials. Other members liked that idea as well.
 - iv. To submit to the newsletter: That information is in the newsletter.

4. Constant Contact

6. Podcast Repository - Richard Rep

 - i. Submit a plan for approval to committee
 - ii. Submit initial video for approval
 - iii. 10 minutes or less in length. Peer reviewed.
 - iv. QuickTime is the preferred format.

 - i. Fits the ATMI mission.
 - ii. Something that is unique (not overly done).
 - iii. Research reports.
 - iv. How to use certain software applications

7. Online Journal Discussion

- a. JTML transition has stalled and we don't see this moving forward any time soon. As a result, we think perhaps we should create our own online peer-reviewed journal. It would need to have an editor and editorial board and articles should be published in a timely manner.

 - v. Dan - multimedia friendly.
 - vi. Jim - if this is a "yes" we need a task force.
 - vii. Jane Kuehne asked for volunteer to head up the task force. She ended up volunteering to head up the task force with the following members to be included:

 - viii. Peter - chair should check with other editors of journals -- what's the submission rate?
 - ix. Jay Dorfman - JRTE - they get a lot of submissions with a 17% acceptance rate. ISTE runs that journal. We need to seriously consider types of submissions. A concern is -- there are areas for people to publish, so we need to be unique. Indicated support for the idea.
 - x. Brendan - isn't it good to have an ebb and flow.
- c. iPhone/iPad App - formatting - should have an app.
 - i. Gena - we need to begin with some kind of online presence, and perhaps we can move forward from that.
